ANNEXURE - 1

Eligibility Criteria:

To be eligible for being a member in the Moot Court Student Body, candidates must meet the following criteria:

1) Oral and Written Skills:

- Demonstrated proficiency in oral advocacy and public speaking, as evidenced by moot court committee presentation during the selection process.
- Strong writing skills, as demonstrated by a legal research memo.

2) Legal Knowledge:

- A solid understanding of legal principles and case law

3) Commitment and Availability:

- Commitment to participate in moot court activities for the duration of the academic year.
- Willingness and availability to dedicate time to team meetings, practice sessions, and competitions.

4) Ethical Standards:

- Adherence to high ethical standards, including academic integrity and professional conduct.

Selection Process:

- The selection will be for twenty posts in the MLU Moot Court Student Body, two posts from each year of 3 years LLB, 5 years B.A.LLB (H) and LLM.
- Top two students selected on the basis of merit shall be chosen as Student Convener and Co-Convener.
- The selection process for the Moot Court Student Body will consist of the following steps:

1. Application Submission – By submitting the application attached in annexure-2 in hard copy to MCC Faculty coordinator **Mr. Bhanu Pratap Singh** within university hour.

2. A written statement of interest (500 words maximum) outlining their motivation for joining the Moot Court Student Body.

3. Screening:

The Moot Court Selection Committee will review all submitted applications to ensure that candidates meet the minimum eligibility criteria.

4. Interview

Shortlisted candidates will be called for an interview.

6. Selection and Announcement:

After completing all stages of the selection process, the Moot Court Selection Committee will evaluate candidates based on their overall performance and fit with the Moot Court Student Body. Successful candidates will be selected, and their names will be announced.
